## Game Day Protocols (Bentley Field Complex. Woodstock CT.)

### Must Do: (Parents and Spectators)

- All parents and spectators must wear face coverings.
- Spectators to player recommended ratio 1-1
- Spectators must remain socially and physically distance from non-family members
- Spectators must stay opposite to their team bench
- All spectators adhere to NEP game guidelines

### Upon Arrival: (Players and Parents)

- Players depart vehicle without parents and proceed to the field with mask on.
- When vehicle is parked please proceed to designated spectator area opposite your team bench with mask on.
- PARENTS & SPECTATORS CANNOT ENTER THE FIELD OF PLAY UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
